An area of high pressure currently centred to the west of Ireland will move slowly southwards as a deepening low develops to the east of Iceland during the next 24 hours, bringing a front to northwestern parts of the United Kingdom, and strengthening westerly winds across northern waters, but light or moderate winds persisting elsewhere.

Mostly dry and rather cloudy, although the odd light shower. Some cloud breaks are likely, giving occasional sunshine, most likely in the east and south. Still slightly chilly in the south after patchy frost and fog, nearer average further north.

A generally Cloudy day over the mountains with a few, mainly light snow showers over the Scottish Ranges, focussed mainly in the West. Mostly Dry in the South and just the Lake District susceptible to summit Fog at times. On the airfields the widespread Frost around the country should have cleared in the South and the Strong Winds appear to be confined to the North for today. Fog in the South should have cleared by now while clearing in Northern England it will return there by mid-afternoon.
