ARCC Brief

A deep area of low pressure currently just to the north of Shetland will move steadily southeast, reaching Denmark by Thursday afternoon. As this low moves through, it will bring a period of gales to northern and eastern waters and strong winds in the south.

Cloud and outbreaks of rain over parts of England and Wales become confined to the far southeast of England by dawn. Clear spells follow, but also some showers, mainly in the north where showers wintry. Windy in the far north.

For the Scottish high ground it's cold with snow showers and strengthening North Westerly winds with severe Gales over the summits by midnight. As you'd expect there's also a Significant wind chill. Generally dry with long clear spells for Northern Ireland and England. However, in Wales it'll be Cloudier with outbreaks of rain turning to snow on the summits above 750m. On the airfields Strong winds in the North and down the West to Cornwall while Gales also affect the Northern region at times. Some early Fog for the Home Counties while it'll stick around the Scottish rural areas. Much clearer though through the middle of the UK while cloud is likely to be 1000ft or lower in the South East.

We do have some significant areas in Northern Ireland and across the whole of the North with Trigger Lightning Hotspots.
