- Interior Minister Darmanin has just tweeted the following (translated): *“Strong emotion as a result of the capsizing of a boat of migrants in the English Channel that has tragically led to numerous deaths. The criminal nature of the smugglers who organise these crossings cannot be emphasised enough. I am going to the scene”.*

Hi Guys – you may have seen news coming through of a capsizing off the coast of Calais, five confirmed fatalities, we understand possibly more. Darmanin has just tweeted about the incident and I believe is on the way up there. Na can share details if not seen.

We shouldn't overstep and try to involve ourselves in the emergency response, but we may want to give the HS a text to send across, simply to say she's seen the terrible news and is ready to offer any help we can. We should avoid any points that could appear at all political or opportunistic (not that we would intentionally do this).
