DOVER COASTGUARD: UK Coastguard, good afternoon.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: (French words spoken) yes, sir? Yes. Dover.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Hello, is that Gris Nez?

FRENCH COASTGUARD: Yes. This is Gris Nez speaking. To inform you now we have a
rescue operation with 38 sorry, with 10 to 15 people in the water.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Yeah.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: Possibly unconscious, not conscious.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Yeah.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: And to know if it's possible for you to send some drone or any
aircraft in vicinity.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Do you have a position?

FRENCH COASTGUARD: Yes, sir. It is 51 degrees 05.58 minutes north.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Yeah.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: And 001 degrees.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Yeah.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: 43.41 East.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Okay. Bear with me. One second. Okay. Yeah. My colleague's just going to be calling our air rescue for support. Do you have any further details?

FRENCH COASTGUARD: Details? What do you mean?

DOVER COASTGUARD: How these people ended up in the water? What are you sending? Anything like that, that we can provide?

FRENCH COASTGUARD: So no we don't know exactly. It's just a report from a fishing vessel. But the fishing vessel states that he prefers not to come back in this area because it's too difficult for him.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Okay. So it was just a report from a fishing vessel. Are you sending anything?

FRENCH COASTGUARD: So now we have sent the Flamant patrol vessel and also we send a helicopter the rescue, Golf Whisky to investigate area.

DOVER COASTGUARD: Okay, not a problem at all. My colleague's just speaking with our air rescue to see if we can get an asset. We will call you back shortly.

FRENCH COASTGUARD: Yeah. Okay.

DOVER COASTGUARD: That's great. Thank you.
