Subject: FW: UPDATE: New Migrant tracker, Responsibilities and Abandoned Migrant Vessel notification

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Good day all,

The mutual migrant tracker has been updated (Master tracker - V2) to accommodate the collation of critical data and information whilst eliminating the need of populating multiple spreadsheets by MAROPS.

Furthermore, the tracker now allows to record information relating to abandoned vessels to inform relevant authorities.

The following changes are to be noted:

- Top left corner next to date cell: Weather assessment box for the day
- Asset tasked column: broken down to RNLI BF Aerial CRT Other
- Beach landing column: drop down list for controlled, not controlled or no beach landing
- Migrant vessel abandonment section on the far right: Position of abandonment, DTG Description along with markings

Which agency is populating what sections and when?

UKBF:

- All columns under 'UKBF' section shown with black font
- Above includes column 'UKBF ref' under the HMCG section (column G)
- 'Migrant vessel abandonment' section when vessel is abandoned by UKBF asset

HMCG:

- All columns under 'HMCG Operations' section including date and weather assessment
- 'Migrant vessel abandonment' section when vessel is abandoned by RNLI asset
- Duplicate of migrant vessel column: this is where we input the daughter incident reference only

- When we have duplicate incidents recorded on the tracker, reasoning to be recorded under Notes column

Last but not least!!! Abandoned Migrant vessel notification.

Upon conclusion of migrant SAR operations, HMCG is to notify Netherlands, Belgian and French Coastguard in relation to abandoned migrant vessels.

This is to be done via Op Deveran mailbox and by copy - paste the Migrant Vessel Abandonment section along with the migrant vessel column on the left to make it obvious which incident is related to which abandoned vessel.

It should look like this:
