



Britain may seem to be close, but it takes too many hours to get there by sea.

- Don't take non-motorized boats
- Keep away from ships; they create large waves and may not be able to see you.
- The weather at sea is colder than on land and is windier.
- Before heading out, check the weather forecast and be cautious of fog and wind.
- If the waves exceed half a meter in height, do not travel.



To save yourself



Call **112** 

- 112 should work fine even if your mobile phone has no signal.
- When you call 112, inform them that you are at sea and need rescue.
- If your mobile phone has a French signal, call 116 to speak directly with France's Coastal Protection.
