



England looks close but reaching it by sea takes many hours.

- Do not do anything without an engine.
- Stay away from ships; they may create huge waves and cannot see you.
- Compared to land, the weather is colder in the ocean and also windier.
- Check the weather before crossing, and be aware of fog and strong winds.
- If the waves are higher than 0.5 meters, do not do anything.

Call 112



- 112 must work even if your telephone does not have a signal.
- When you call 112, tell them you are in the ocean and need to be rescued.
- If your telephone has a French carrier, call 196 to contact the French coast guard directly.
