





When calling for rescue, give your location by GPS

Even if you don't have a phone signal or internet connection, GPS still works, and you are still can call 112




If you have an internet connection, send your GPS via WhatsApp in order for them to be sent easily



1) Turned the location on or open an application like google map.



Tap on Crosshair, it might take a little while, but your location will appear as a blue dot Even on a map, this is your current location



Tap on the blue dot until a pin (several digits) appears on your current location ● ✓



Your location should appear on the upper side of the screen, if not, bring the thing down to look for it.





Give these numbers when asking for rescue, if the second number starts with (-), then look more accurately.



1) Make sure your Location is on, then run WhatsApp.

2) To share your location with someone you want them to know it, inside the messaging box tap on paperclip icon.



3) Then tap on location
